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

Senior Services provides educational, social, leisure and recreational activities for senior citizens that are looking to have some

fun, make new friends, and find socialization and stimulation.



Our daily Congregate program includes entertainment, field trips, Bingo, crafts and educational guest speakers that address

many important issues that relate to senior citizens. Lunch is served daily and transportation is available upon request. Those wishing to participate must be at least 60 years of age and live in Cherokee County.

INFORMATION & ASSISTANCE: Our trained and experienced specialist answers questions and connect seniors and their families with a network of services and programs, call **770-345-5320** or **770-345-5312**.

CAREGIVER: Education, information and emotional support is available for Caregivers. Monthly caregiver meetings provide networking and socializing for those who find themselves in the role of caregiver. **770-345-5312**

CASE MANAGEMENT: The Case Manager completes an initial in-home assessment and arranges for needed services provided by Cherokee County Senior Services and other agencies in the community. Case Managers work with each client and their family members on an on-going basis to ensure that services are being provided and the needs of the seniors are being met. CONGREGATE PROGRAM: Senior Services provides daily activities and a nutritious meal to seniors who come to the center. Crafts, games shopping and field trips, exercise and guest speakers are included. Call **770-345-6730**

SATELLITE CENTERS: We have two satellite centers, (Ball Ground & Waleska). The satellites operate 1 day per week. Call **770-345-6730**.

HOMEMAKER SERVICES: Skilled Homemaker Aides provide in-home assistance to older adults who need help with light housekeeping tasks, grocery shopping or light meal preparation. We also offer Alzheimer and Respite services. Call **770-345-3297**

HOME DELIVERED MEALS: Meals-On-Wheels provides a hot, well-balanced meal each weekday to homebound seniors age 60 and above that are nutritionally at risk. Frozen or shelf staples are

provided for weekend meals and can be used when deliveries cannot be made due to inclement weather, etc. Call **770-345-5320**

TRANSPORTATION: Senior Services contracts with CATS to provide transportation to and from the senior center's morning program, scheduled field trips, grocery shopping and medical appointments. **CATS 770-345-6238**

Transportation Voucher Program provides seniors with transportation for essential travel needs, (physician visits etc..) Call **770-345-7515**

VOLUNTEER SERVICES: Volunteers are always needed in the MOW's delivery, Congregate programs and various fundraising projects throughout the year. Call **770-345-7440**

RESPIRE CARE: Trained staff provides respite care to individuals who are caring for a family member suffering from Alzheimer's. This gives the caregiver a short mental and physical break and an opportunity to focus on themselves briefly. Call **770-345-5320**
