FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM INFORMATION

- The Financial Assistance Program may assist eligible households with rent and utilities
- Partial financial assistance may be given for 1 month (the most current month) of rent and/or 1 utility bill
- Utility assistance is offered for electricity, gas, and water
- Utility bills must be in the applicant's name if applying for utility assistance
- Applicant's name must be on the lease agreement if applying for rental assistance
- Landlord must be willing to cooperate with MUST Ministries if applying for rental assistance
- Mortgage assistance is not offered
- Financial assistance is provided to eligible households only once within a 12-month period for rent and utilities
- Deposits, late fees, and other administrative fees are not covered by the program
- MUST Ministries will evaluate household income and expenses to determine eligibility
- Completing an interview, submitting documents, and completing an application does not guarantee assistance
- Residency in Cherokee County is required
