

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE
CHEROKEE COUNTY CDBG 2020 CARES ACT FUNDING PLAN

A public hearing will be held Friday, November 20, 2020 at 10:00 am in keeping with federal, state, local, and CDC Guidelines for social distancing and group settings. The intent of the hearing is to receive comments on the recommended content of Cherokee County's proposed funding for activities that prepare for, prevent, and respond to the spread of COVID-19, made available by a second allocation of the CARES Act CDBG grant. The list of projects that are proposed to receive funding through HUD's Community Development Block Grant CARES Act allocation [CDBG-CV] is provided in this notice and funds will primarily be used to serve the needs of low and moderate income persons. To expedite the use of the allocation, the County will amend its Action Plan of 2019 to add additional resources of \$963,616. To receive funding, the County will open a comment period on November 12, 2020 and receive written comments until 5:00 pm, November 20, 2020.
