


Beginning August 1st 2008, Cherokee County will begin to standardize the assignation of unit numbers for apartment buildings, in order to facilitate E911 response and clarify postal delivery. The following information is provided for your use. Compliance is highly recommended to ensure speed and efficiency of the administration of public services. Questions may be directed to the Cherokee County GIS Dept, or Development Services Center.

Assigning Apartment Numbers

Unit numbers are to be assigned from left to right in ascending order, sequentially, with 100 range restricted to ground level, 2nd floor 200's, 3rd floor 300's as so on. The tenant will use the entire number scheme, as described below when describing his/her address, as in 24201 Smith St.



The full unit number will be placed on the door of each unit's main entrance, at least 3 inches in height, in a contrasting color, in accordance with local ordinances.

The building numbers will be clearly displayed on the side facing the right-ofway, in a contrasting color, and no less than 3 inches in height, in accordance with local ordinances.
