SHOULD I GO TO URGENT CARE?

Urgent care centers are perfect for most non-emergency situations. They're also ideal if something happens outside of normal business hours. Most urgent care clinics are open late during the week and on weekends, when most doctors' offices are typically closed. An urgent care can also be a good option when you can't get a quick appointment with your primary care doctor.

Emergency rooms are perfect for emergency situations. If you have a life-threatening condition, go straight to the nearest ER.



Driving in winter requires patience and skill. Slick or icy roads can cause a vehicle to lose traction and result in an uncontrolled skid. The main things to remember when driving in winter weather are to SLOW DOWN and OBSERVE SPACE.



In good driving conditions, maintain a two-second following distance. In poor driving conditions (such as snow or ice), maintain a four-or-more second following distance.


