P.I. No. 0013525 - Bells Ferry Road/CR 770 Bridge Replacement at the Little River, Lake Allatoona.

P.I. No. 0013526 - Bells Ferry Road/CR 770 Widening between South Fork Way and Victoria Road. The two-lane roadway will be widened to a four-lane roadway with a raised median.

The purpose of this Public Information Open House is to provide the public with an opportunity to view the proposed projects, ask questions, and to provide an opportunity for the public to comment on the projects.

The Open House will be held from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. It will be informal, and the public is invited to attend anytime during these hours. There will be no formal presentation.

Bells Ferry Road Widening and Reconstruction - P.I. No. 0013526

Description: The project will widen the existing two-lane roadway to a four-lane roadway with raised median and curb and gutter. The project will include designated turn lanes at selected intersections along the corridor as well as the use of restricted crossing U-turn (RCUT) intersections at selected side roads. The project will include a 5' sidewalk on the west side of Bells Ferry Road and a 10' shared use path on the east side. Existing signalized intersections would continue to be signalized with signal replacements. The project will be constructed under traffic with some isolated detours.

Bells Ferry Road Bridge Replacement - P.I. No: 0013525
