Ordinance Overview


- Chapter 6 Alcoholic Beverages of the Code of Ordinances Amended (Chapter 6, Article II, Division 2 – Distilled Spirits)
- Adopted May 16, Effective September 1, 2023
- Administrative Policy Adopted June 6, 2023
 - ➤ Applications accepted beginning 9:00 AM September 1 through 5:00 PM on October 31, 2023
 - ➤ Must submit in person with Development Services Center




Ordinance Overview

- Section 6-83 Distilled spirits retail districts, location requirements
 - ➤ Distilled Spirits Retail Districts Six (6) Districts
 - ➤ Zoning General Commercial, TND, PUD-Commercial and a Special Use Permit (SUP) is Required
- Section 6-24 Measurement of Distances
- Section 6-84 Building Requirements
 - ➤ Sole tenants in freestanding buildings of at least 5,000 square feet in size
 - ➤ 100 feet of frontage on an arterial or major collector street
 - Building Design, Signage, Security Cameras Required
 - ➤ See Additional Requirements

Application Process Overview

• Section 6-85. License, administrative, and investigative requirements; licensing process; fees.

Review Section 6-85 Carefully

- Section 6-85 (b): Licensing process:
- ➤ Step 1: Submit Application beginning September 1
- ➤ Step 2: Completeness Review
- ➤ Step 3: Preliminary Certificate of Compliance (Finalists)
- ➤ Step 4: Finalists presented to BOC

Lottery Called & Conducted

\$135,000 License Fee Due



Application Process Overview

- ➤ Step 5: Special Use Permit (SUP) Application, 90 Days to apply
- ➤ Step 6: Special Use Permit (SUP) Process, 180 Days to receive a decision
- ➤ Step 7: With SUP, Conditional License Issued
- ➤ Step 8: Project Completion Two (2) Years
- ➤ Step 9: With C.O. Issued, Conditional License converted to Retail Distilled Spirits Alcohol License
- **► Application with Department of Revenue filed after SUP is approved**Cherokee County

Application Process Overview

- Alcoholic Beverage License documents include (See Sec. 6-5 et seq):
 - -Complete application; complete licensee application
 - -SAVE affidavit; Private employer affidavit
 - -Fingerprint/background check consent form
 - -RASS certificate
 - -Site Plan/Concept
 - -Distance Survey
 - -Residential Distance Waiver, if applicable
 - -Residency Waiver, if applicable
 - -Proof of GA Residency



Lottery

- Will be at a scheduled BOC meeting
- Conducted by Independent Third Party
- For each district, the lottery will generate an ordered list of finalists
- If the successful finalist's (#1 on the list) application is void, the next ranked on the list will emerge and proceed through the process



License Fees

- Application fee of \$500 and \$50 Fingerprinting Fee nonrefundable, but later credited toward the \$135,000 license fee
- \$135,000 License Fee Due upon becoming Successful Finalist, selected by the Lottery
- Up to 50% of fee, \$67,500, used as a credit for any impact, permit, or application fees due to Cherokee County and CCWSA to offset project costs
- If a Successful Finalist is unable to complete the process, applicants may request a pro-rated refund against fees not otherwise incurred
